

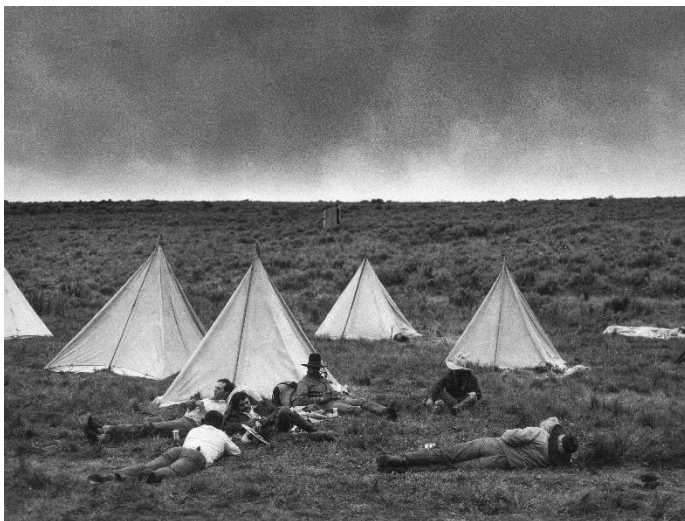
### **James Warner Barrie (Jim Barrie)**
